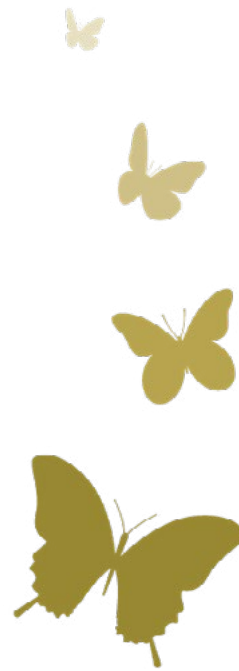

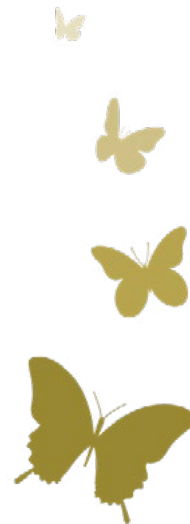

1. Call 999 and ask for the South West Ambulance Service. Tell them where you are.
2. They will give you a special code. Key this code into the keypad on the cabinet and it will open.
3. Get out the defibrillator. The Ambulance service will tell you what to do.

## Major Emergency

There is now a Community Emergency Plan for the Weston area, set up by the Weston Resilience Team in association with B&NES Council. This Plan will come into action in the event of a major emergency being declared in this area. **Weston Free Church (Moravian) and Hall** are designated as the Primary Assembly Point in Weston, where the emergency services can interact with the local community, following the guidelines in the Plan. A similar plan for the Newbridge area is also being developed. If you wish to report an emergency, please ring **999**.

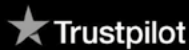

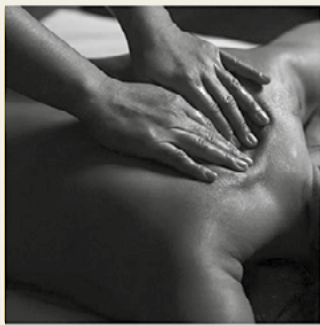
